

## Ontario Solitary Confinement Class Action

Koskie Minsky LLP is counsel in a class action against the Province of Ontario alleging human rights violations relating to the over-use of solitary confinement in Ontario provincial prisons.

The deadline to submit a claim for the Ontario Administrative Segregation Settlement expired on June 1, 2025.

You may be able to file a late claim if you follow the Court-ordered distribution protocol.

The protocol states:

Claimants whose Claims Forms have been denied as untimely may seek leave from the Court to file a late Claims Form, but leave shall be granted only if the Claimant establishes that the failure to file a timely Claims Form was due to circumstances beyond their control or that provide a reasonable explanation for the delay. Such a Claimant is not eligible for a share of the NADA and must elect to proceed by Track 2 or 3.

You may be a Class Member if the following applies to you:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You stayed in Administrative Segregation in an Ontario Jail, except the St. Lawrence Valley Correctional and Treatment Centre;</li> <li>• For 15 or more consecutive days;</li> <li>• Between April 20, 2015 and August 18, 2021.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You stayed in Administrative Segregation in an Ontario Jail, except the St. Lawrence Valley Correctional and Treatment Centre, for any length of time, between April 20, 2015 and August 18, 2021;</li> <li>• You were diagnosed by a medical doctor with an eligible mental health disorder before or during your incarceration;</li> <li>• AND you reported your diagnosis and suffering to Ontario's agents or employees before or during your stay in Administrative Segregation</li> </ul> <p>Some exceptions apply.</p>

The Court decided that Class Members who stayed in Administrative Segregation, ONLY between January 1, 2009 and April 19, 2015, cannot make a claim unless they can prove that they could not make a claim before April 20, 2015.
